







#### Share of export in GDP in LT is twice higher than EU average







#### Lithuanian manufacturing is increasing its orientation towards export markets








#### Lithuanian export and manufacturing demonstrate very dynamic growth



#### EU remains Lithuania's largest export partner; share of CIS is dropping


Structure of export of goods of Lithuanian origin (excl. oil, tobacco and fertilizers), %








Change in export of goods of Lithuanian origin (excl. oil, tobacco and fertilizers), %




### Lithuanian exporters are becoming more dependent on Scandinavia

#### Uncertainties about Swedish economy are pressing on the Swedish Krona

  - Beneficial for LT contract manufacturing companies;
    - Swedish exporters become more competitive in foreign markets.
  - Bad for LT companies that export final goods to Sweden.




#### Euro zone economy: running out of steam?





Lithuania: industrial production capacity utilization level, %




#### Will LT manufacturing manage to sustain its competitiveness?

Change in manufacturing output and empolyment in Lithuanian manufacturing in 2017, compared to 2008, %






Change in 2017, compared to 2008

■ Manufacturing: production output



#### Robotization in the EU: challenge or opportunity to LT business?


Manufacturing: change in production output and number of employees in 2017, compared to 2010, %
