

MITA support for clusters members (1)

- Inostart: promote the creation and development of new innovative small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) by ensuring the development of innovative ideas, products and services (R&D activities from idea to commercialization).
- Inovoucher: promote the acquisition of services of science and study institutions for the preparation of technical feasibility studies and implementation of R&D activities.
- Commercialization of R&D results and promotion of internationalization (planning): promote scientists and other researchers and students working / studying in science and study institutions, to commercialize R&D results by creating spin-offs (R&D activities from prototype to product, service commercialization).



MITA support for clusters members (2)

- Norway Grants programme "Business Development, Innovation and SMEs": development of new environmentally friendly products or technologies.
- ✓ "Inopatent": patenting of inventions, design registration.
- More planned programs: support for green, eco-innovation (for startups and ventures); support for biotechnology innovation, etc.



InoConnect

- Who can apply: Lithuanian science and technology parks, clusters, enterprises;
- Aim: promote international partnerships and networking;
- Funded activities: participation in the events of international R & D & I activity initiatives;
- Eligible costs: salaries and travel expenses of the project staff (company staff);
- Funding: up to 10 000 Eur;
- Deadline for Applications: 30 November 2020;

Supporting European SMEs to participate in public procurement outside EU

- Who can apply: project consortia representing Chambers of Commerce, federations, cluster organizations, NPO's, public bodies, universities, educational institutions, research centres from COSME countries (including Sakartvelo);
- Aim: improve SMEs' access to public procurement in the non-EU countries with which the European Union has signed a bilateral or plurilateral agreement covering public procurement;
- Funded activities: 1) develop an internationalisation strategy and its implementation roadmap, based on the targeted Member States and third countries; 2) apply the internationalisation strategy, gather data, promote the project and disseminate results;
- Funding: up to 400 000 Eur per project;
- Deadline for Applications: 15 September 2020;

European Brain Research area (EBRA) call



- Who can apply: research clusters (including Sakartvelo);
- Aim: promote coordination and collaboration among research networks and projects that share the common goal of understanding the brain and its disorders;
- Funded activities: networking; expert advice on data related issues and exploitation of results; links with existing research infrastructures; communication and dissemination;
- Eligible costs: part of the costs for venue hire, catering, travel expenses and communication materials;
- **Deadline for Applications: 1** January 2021.


