






... To Generate & better capitalise on all forms of knowledge, creativity, craftsmanship & innovation

... To bring their cross-cutting technologies, service innovation & eco-innovative solutions into new industrial value chains






Why cross-sectoral collaboration matters?

... offer further funding opportunities for possible collaboration ideas


... trigger complementary support via linking sectors & partners to smart specialisation priorities






European Strategic Cluster Partnerships for smart specialisation investments

- more than 4.500 SMEs directly or indirectly benefited
- complement mobilisation of interregional RIS3 partnerships of regional authorities under Smart Specialisation Platform
- for Industrial Modernisation
- promoting joint innovation investments along a smart specialisation priority area related to industrial modernisation




'EU Clusters Go International' action


